

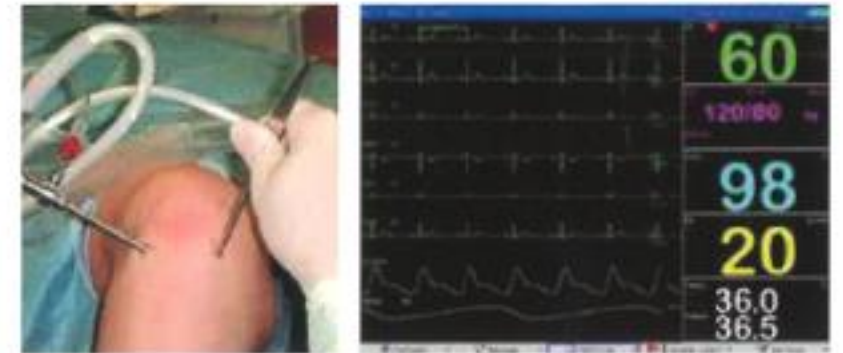
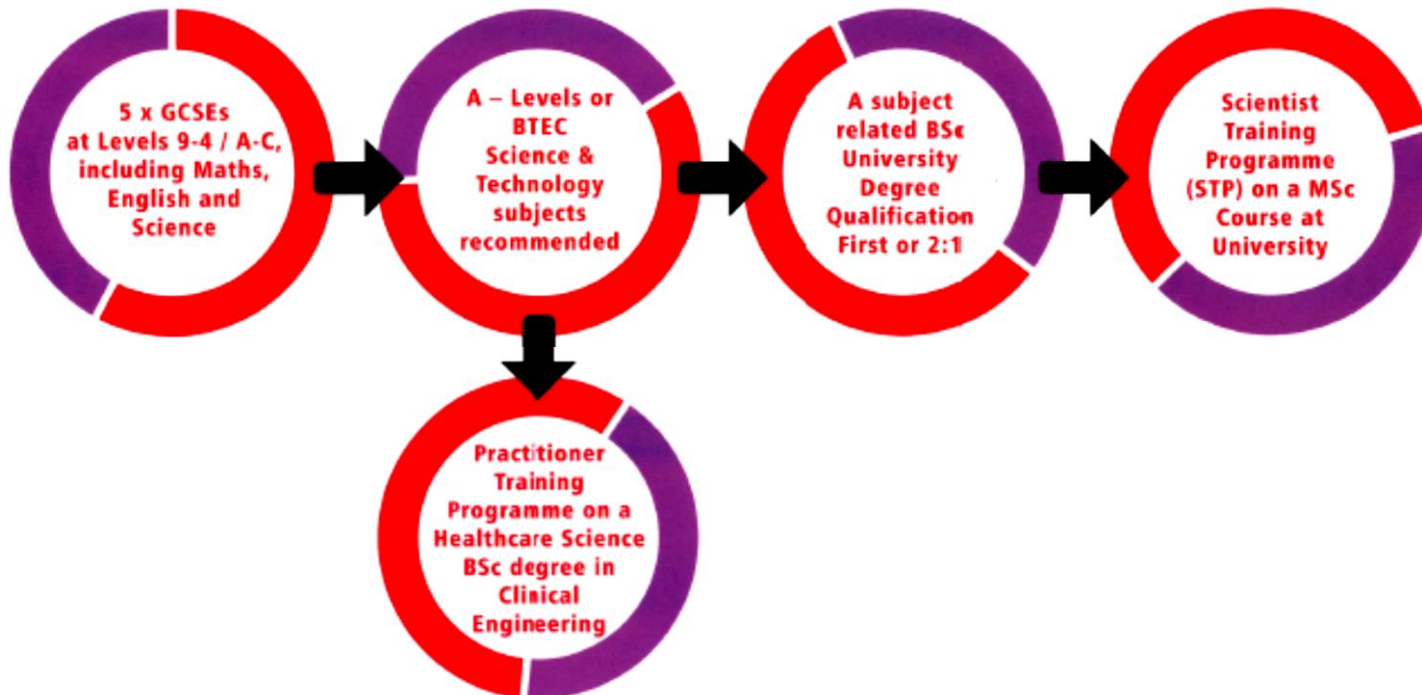

Working closely with patients, technical and medical staff, these guys design and develop modern, cutting edge equipment to help the diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of patients. This can be from the non-invasive keyhole surgery to a new prosthetic that responds to muscle stimulation. They also are involved in all the monitors and kit that patients are hooked up to in hospitals to monitor their vital signs. A day could involve repairing a blood pressure machine to calibrating a piece of intensive care equipment that will keep someone alive!
