Face Masks – mandatory from Monday 28th September

Thank you for your support so far this term as we have welcomed students back and familiarised them with our new routines and expectations. We have been monitoring these closely and tweaking plans where necessary.

From next Monday (28th September) we will be insisting upon the wearing of masks during lesson changeovers and other movement times. We had previously communicated that masks were 'recommended', but from Monday they will be mandatory. We will not be asking students to wear masks in lessons, but when they are moving around the site.

Please discuss with your son/daughter that wearing a mask will be a requirement from the start of next week, but do encourage them to start wearing one immediately if possible. Our children have been magnificent so far in how they have adapted to the changes in school. We must all impress upon them that we follow the guidance in a spirit of love for each other and that we all have a responsibility to keep each other safe.


